

SOP for Creating an Event for Veer Baal Diwas on MyBharat PO Page

The upcoming **Veer Baal Diwas** event, celebrated across India, will be organized by NSS POs and the event will be created on their MY Bharat PO pages. The event can be created and posted by following these steps:


1. Sign In -

- Go to MyBharat Portal on mybharat.gov.in
- Sign in to your PO Page using the NSS PO credentials (Email/Mobile Number).



The PO can choose any activity such as plantation drives, debate competitions, awareness workshops, or any other relevant initiative aligned with the theme of Veer Baal Diwas.

Click on **Add More** to include additional activities (if any) in a similar manner.

xiv. Upload Task Image - Upload the approved event banner for Veer Baal Diwas.

xiv. Publish the Event - At last, click on the Publish button to make the event visible to NSS students.
